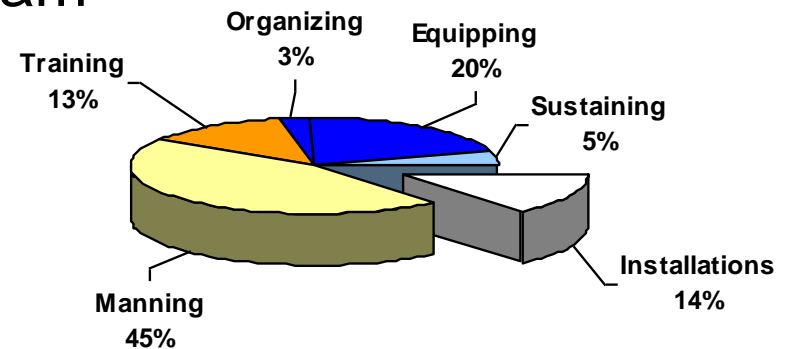


Installation Status Report Program



121ST ENGINEER REGIMENT, MARYLAND DEFENSE FORCE

- BLUF: Facility inspection program of all Army National Guard infrastructure on an annual basis with automated reporting
- The ISR program is a vital part of the Army's Installation Management Program
 - Helps the Army provide quality, effective, efficient and consistent support to the war fighter
 - Supports funds allocation
 - ISR helps to build the best case for securing resources
- TAGs are required to complete accurate and timely annual ISR reports





Installation Status Report Program



121ST ENGINEER REGIMENT, MARYLAND DEFENSE FORCE



- Army-wide standards to assess the physical condition and readiness of facilities
- Identify substandard or unavailable facilities, which negatively impact installation mission
- Identify facility revitalization and construction requirements, and estimate macro-level planning costs consistently (POM/FYDP)



Instillation Status Report Program



121ST ENGINEER REGIMENT, MARYLAND DEFENSE FORCE

- Since 2006 the 121st Engineer Regiment of the Maryland Defense Force has supported the Maryland Military Department by completing the annual ISRs
 - More than 40 armories and other facilities inspected annually
 - Each cycle of inspections takes place over 5 months
 - More that 2200 hours (>\$150K) in support

- Through ISR program execution the MDDF has been able to
 - Identify significant issues that effect both operational readiness and quality of life for our fellow soldiers, and
 - Build an excellent relationship with CFMO
 - Bottom line....after 6 years of execution the MDARNG no longer knows how to execute this program

- The MDDF through the ISR program has also been able to assist in addressing a number of serious safety issues



Key Elements

- Effective Training of both National Guard and MDDF personnel
- Demonstrated C2 and individual Soldier professionalism key to acceptance by National Guard personnel
