The MEMS Academy welcomes the participation of all military academies into the Military Emergency Management Specialist (MEMS) training and certification program.

Many of the MEMS Academy training courses have a component of leadership built into the training. This will help develop the students attending Military Academy to further their leadership skills and develop a interest in emergency management in their community

The competition for entry into our colleges and universities is increasingly difficult. Universities and Colleges now offer degrees in Emergency Management and the MEMS Academy training and certification program will assist those students in their future endeavors to succeed in that field. JRTOC students will be able to secure college credits for their completion of FEMA courses as well as to develop interest in emergency management.

The MEMS Training program will enhance the Military Academies and JROTC students with their leadership skills and develop an understanding of emergency management for a possible career path.

To accommodate the Military Academy programs, we have revised the SGAUS membership fee and the Practicum (AAR)

section of the MEMS Student Guidelines for military academy students.

In the case of a military academy, we will work with the students and their academy supervisors to choose a function that the academy and the student have or will participate in that would be suitable for the practicum.

In all these circumstances the student must have participated in the activity under the supervision of a member of the military academy staff who can vouch for the student's participation
